## CONNECTICUT

- CR01** Waste PCBs with concentrations greater than or equal to 50 ppm
- CR02** Waste oil not water soluble
- CR03** Waste oil that is water soluble
- CR04** Waste chemical liquids that are toxic, hazardous to handle, and/or may cause contamination of ground and/or surface water
- CR05** Waste chemical solids or semi-solids

## MAINE

- M002** PCB toxic waste
- K###** Process specific wastes not federally listed (call for more info)
- P###** Chemical specific wastes not federally listed (call for more info)
- U###** Chemical specific waste not federally listed (call for more info)

## MASSACHUSETTS

- MA00** Hazardous waste as designated by 310 CMR 30.144
- MA01** Waste Oil
- MA95** Universal waste shipped on hazardous waste manifest by a licensed hazardous waste transporter
- MA97** Class A regulated recyclable material (including but not limited to used oil fuel) that is shipped on a hazardous waste manifest
- MA98** Off-specification used oil fuel that is shipped using a hazardous waste manifest
- MA99** Not hazardous waste

## NEW HAMPSHIRE

- NHX1** Exempt, recycled hazardous waste
- NH01** Used Oil
- NH02** Corrosive Solid
- NH03** Strontium Sulfide

## RHODE ISLAND

- R001** Toxic Waste (Type 1A, 1B, or 1C)
- R002** Reactive Waste (Type 2A, 2B, or 2C)
- R003** Flammable Waste (Type 3A, 3B, or 3C)
- R004** Corrosive waste
- R005** RI special hazardous waste doesn't meet any other criteria but may pose a potential hazard to human health or environment
- R006** Extremely hazardous waste
- R007** PCB waste greater than or equal to 50 ppm
- R010** Waste used oil
- R011** Secondary waste generated by a hazardous waste management facility as a result of treatment
- R012** Precious metal bearing waste
- R013** Household hazardous waste
- R014** Waste used oil managed by re-refining or burned for energy recovery
- R015** Waste not meeting the definition of hazardous waste that is required to be on a manifest by the destination state
- R016** Removal action waste generated by RI DEM / US EPA if the governing body is not responsible party

## VERMONT

- VT01** Wastes containing PCB in concentrations equal or greater than 50 parts per million
- VT02** Waste containing greater than 5% by weight of petroleum distillates with melting points of less than 100F, (e.g., fuel oil, hydraulic oils, automotive oils)
- VT03** Waste water-miscible metal cutting and grinding fluid
- VT06** Pesticidal wastes and obsolete pesticidal products not specifically listed in subchapter 2
- VT08** Waste ethylene glycol and solutions containing greater than 700 parts per million of ethylene glycol (e.g., coolants, antifreeze)
- VT11** Wastes determined to be hazardous pursuant to § 7-213 or § 7-216
- VT20** A solid material that when mixed with an equal weight of distilled water causes the liquid fraction of the mixture to exhibit the properties of corrosivity characteristic as specified in § 7-206(a)(3)
- VT99** Non-hazardous waste
