

HELPFUL HANDLING HINTS FROM WORKWASTE FOR:

Batteries

REMEMBER:

- Collect batteries in 5-gallon plastic containers with lids
- Attach "Universal Waste Battery" label to container
- Mark date when first accumulated
- Different battery types should be segregated (separate containers, baggies, or taped terminals)
- Keep container closed at all times
- Maintain copies of all shipping paperwork
- Train employees
- Any leaking batteries should be containerized in dedicated container
- **NO OTHER WASTE PERMITTED**
